



Terms and Conditions - Junior Ambassador Programme

We are so looking forward to receiving your nominations to our Young Tree Champions Junior Ambassador programme. The deadline for entries is 5 January 2023.

Before you enter a child's nomination, please make sure you've read through and understand the terms and conditions below, as well as any additional guidelines listed on the Junior Ambassador webpage and application form. By nominating a child, you are agreeing to be bound by these terms and conditions.

1. This programme is open to children who are aged between 7 and 14 (Year 3 to year 9) on the 5 January 2023.
2. Only children who are based in the United Kingdom and whose nomination is submitted by a known teacher from a Young Tree Champion school will be assessed. Evidence of age and residency may be required. Entries received from anyone outside this age group or that do not comply with these terms and conditions will not be eligible.
3. Nominations are free.
4. You can only submit two nominations per school. We encourage team work so schools only submitting one nomination will not be considered.
5. An entry can only be submitted by a teacher or youth leader from the school or youth group that the child is attending.
6. The teacher requires consent from the child's parent(s)/guardian(s).
7. Nominations can be from mixed years and ages but must be from the same school.
8. The nomination must be completed by the teacher, with support from the nominated Junior Ambassadors.
9. Entries should be uploaded via The Tree Council's Young Tree Champion website.
10. Nominations must be received by The Tree Council by 23.59 GMT on 5 January 2023. Any nominations received after that date and time will not be eligible for consideration.
11. The Senior Ambassadors and National Schools Team will select the Junior Ambassadors. Their decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into concerning this decision.
12. The lead teacher or youth leader will be notified if their nomination has been successful by the 9 January 2023. Unsuccessful nominations will be notified by 16 January 2023.
13. A pack containing a letter of congratulations, masterclass passport and metal pin-badge will be sent out to the lead teacher or youth leader of successful applicants to give to their new Junior Ambassadors.
14. The official Junior Ambassador team will be announced via The Tree Council website and social media channels in January 2023.
15. All TTC staff and senior ambassadors delivering masterclasses have an enhanced DBS, we require the lead teacher or youth leader to sign in and support each masterclass selected by their junior ambassador.
16. By sharing the information necessary to complete the application form, you agree to the processing, storage, sharing and use of this information for the purpose of managing your application, in accordance with [The Tree Council's Privacy Policy](#) and in compliance with the Data Protection Act 2018.
